

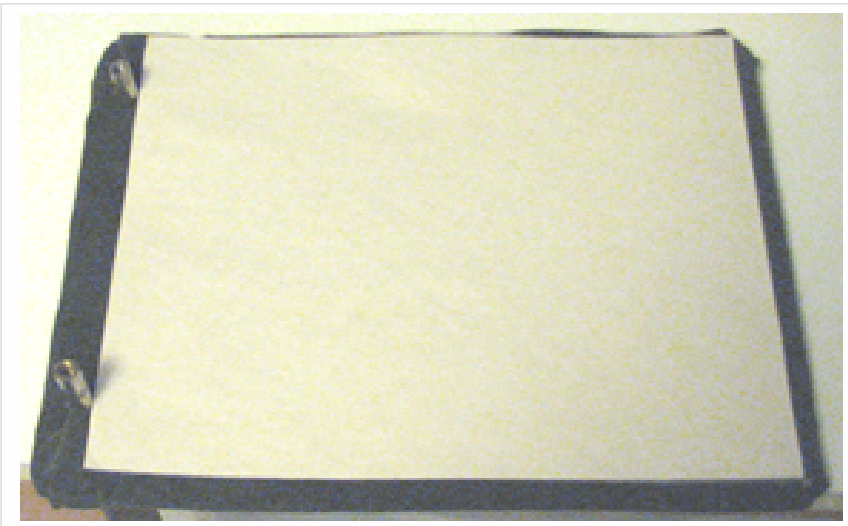
THE ANACHRONISM - CIRCA 1900



THIS IS THE BOTTOM PART OF AN OLDER TWO PIECE JOURNAL THAT WAS NOT TO BE DAMAGED OR ALTERED IN ANYWAY, BUT NEEDED TO BE RECOVERED – TO MAKE IT LOOK NEW AGAIN FOR CIRCA 1900.

I FIGURED THE ONLY WAY TO DO THAT WITHOUT TOUCHING IT - WAS TO BASICALLY 'SLIP COVER' IT. THE MATERIAL FOR THE COVER WAS TAPED USING DOUBLE SIDED TAPE ALONG THE TOP OF THE EXCESS EDGING AND I USED CONSTRUCTION PAPER TO HOLD IT ALL TOGETHER SNUGGLY.

THE SAME PAPER WAS USED AS THE NEW PAGES FOR THE JOURNAL. THE TOP HAD PIECES OF LEATHER PULLED AROUND THE CORNERS USING THE SAME DOUBLE SIDED TAPE.



AN INK PAD WAS ALSO NEEDED TO BE MADE AND STAINED - BLUE FELT ADDED. CLASPS AND CORNERS FOR AN AUTHENTIC TOUCH.
